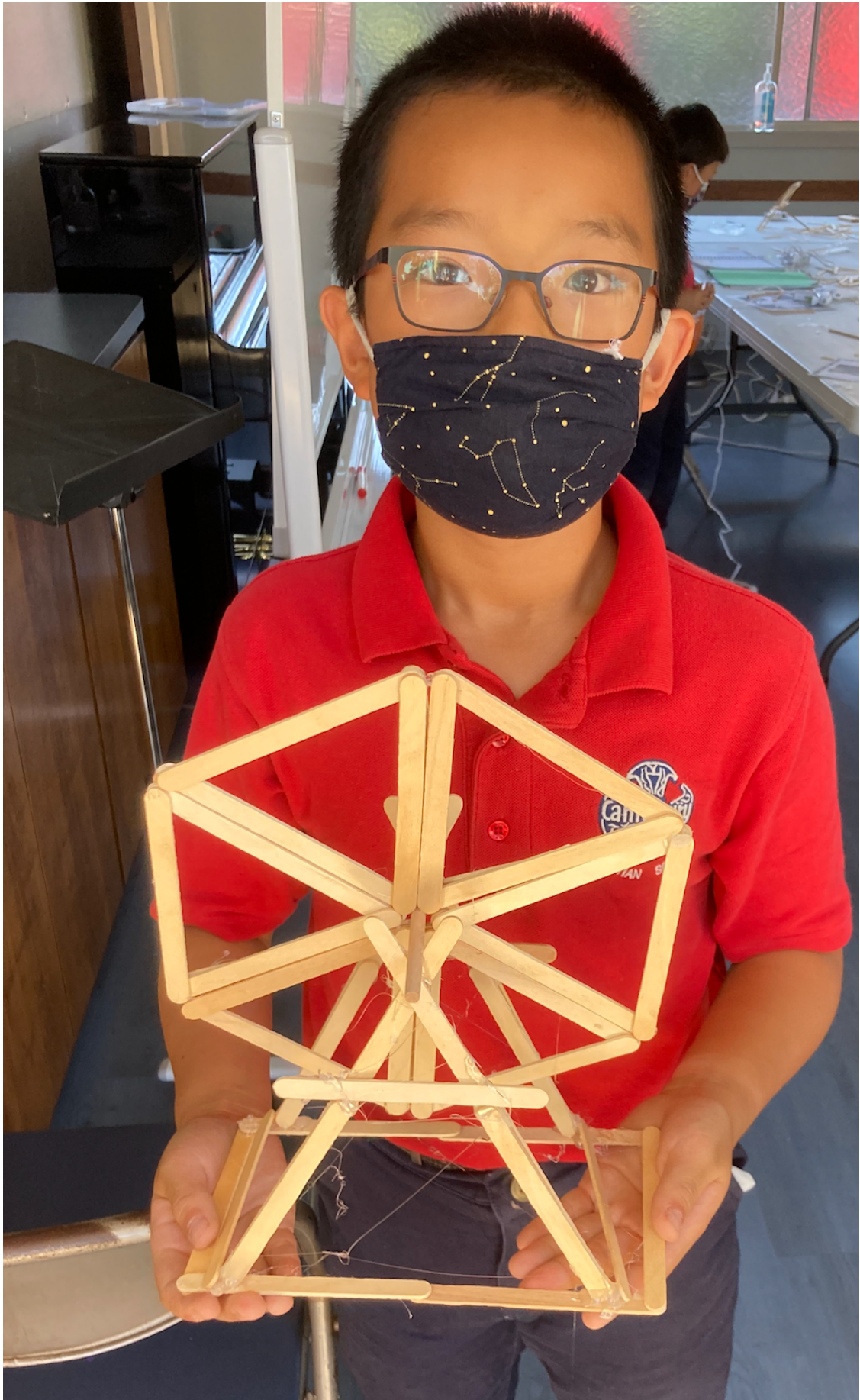
City Team Hygiene Kit Drive

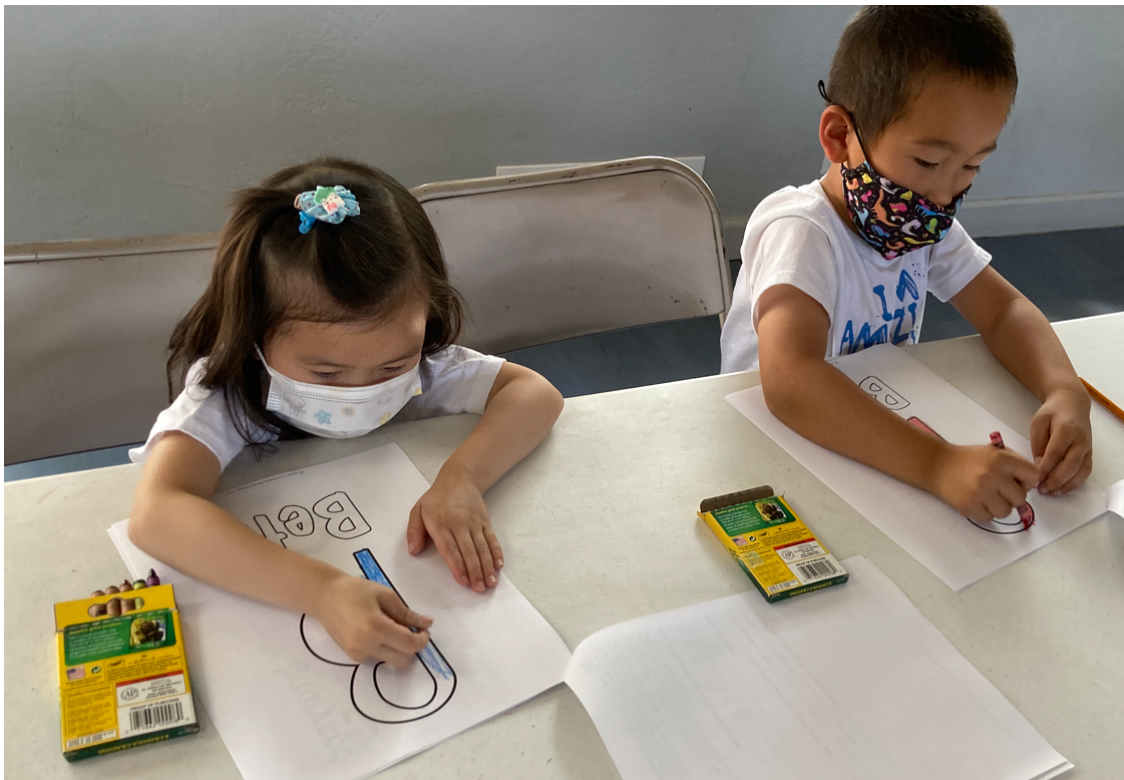
Invite a Friend to our October Open House
